DIRECT PAYMENT AND PERSONAL HEALTH BUDGET SUPPORT

Our Health and Independence team provides support for people who are in receipt of Direct Payments or a Personal Health Budget in relation to their social care needs.

We provide a range of support to our Direct Payment recipients, to manage their budget in a way that suits them. This includes information and support whilst on Direct Payments or a Personal Health Budget.

We provide 3 levels of support to suit each individual's need –

Level 1 – you manage your own budget where you are supported by a care agency or attend a day centre, with the support of the Direct Payments Team.

Level 2 – you manage your own budget where you are supported by a Personal Assistant, with the support of the Direct Payments Team.

Level 3 – your Direct Payments Support Team manage your budget on your behalf where you are supported by a care agency or attend a day centre, by opening an individual bank account.

For Personal Health Budgets, this can include extensive support around payroll services and management of accounts.

We aim to give you the independence to make informed choices around your care and support and how you will manage your budget.
